Hearing the Spirit: Five Questions to Ask the Lord.

"Look! I have been standing at the door, and I am constantly knocking. If anyone hears me calling him and opens the door, I will come in and <u>fellowship with him and he with me</u>." Revelation 3:20 TLB

"He who has an ear, <u>let him hear</u> what the Spirit says to the churches." Revelation 3:22 NASB

"Listening Prayer:" Five questions to ask the Lord. The Spirit of Truth will guide you into all the truth.

- 1. WHAT? Lord, what is on Your heart? What do You want me to know? Talk to me. For example:
 - a. I want to know You better, more intimately, as my Friend, Bridegroom and King. Share Your heart.
 - b. Lead me to become more conformed to Your image, Lord Jesus. Show me Yourself Your glory.
 - c. Tell me about this critical moment in world history as Your kingdom draws near, so I can intercede.
 - d. How do I pray in this situation or challenge facing the Church, and my local church in particular?
 - e. I seek Your wisdom in facing a hard decision or issue in my personal life, or with family or friends.
 - f. Show me what You would say or do for this hurting, broken person in front of me right now in this ministry moment. Jesus, like You, I want to do what the Father is doing. John 5:19; 8:38

2. REALLY? Lord, I need to know that this is really You speaking? So . . .

- a. Please confirm this impression through Your written Word, the Bible.
- b. Would You clarify and confirm what I perceive You are saying as I quietly wait on Your Spirit?
- c. I anticipate that you may use other gifted believers or circumstances to confirm it. Open my eyes.
- d. And here's why I need clarification: "IF YOU SPEAK <u>CLEARLY</u>, I WILL OBEY <u>COURAGEOUSLY</u>!"
- 3. WHY? Lord, why did you tell me this. Was it to prompt me to action, or just because I asked?
 - a. Is this a secret Friend to friend that is an intimate disclosure for me alone to enjoy right now?
 - b. Is this a clue something I am to search out and explore in Scripture, to be clarified over time?
 - c. Is this heart-perception a prophetic insight a timely, specific prompting for intercession or action?
 - d. Is it a directive Do You want me to take action, such as offering this prompting to another?
 - e. Is it not for me to ask "why" right now? I know the explanation will come in Your timing. I'll wait.

4. WHEN? Lord, if You are directing me to offer this prompting to others, tell me when.

- a. Is now the time, and is this the place? An anointed ministry is as much related to timing as to truth.
- b. If not now, when? I will be prepared and watch for Your open door. I stand patiently ready to obey.
- c. How much? All or part? Which part of this "word from the Lord" do You want me to share now?

5. HOW? Lord, how would you guide me to present this truth to others? I need both tack and courage.

- a. **Privately** or **publicly**? Do I share specifically to an individual, or generally to the whole group?
- b. Gently? If so, I will "offer and release" rather than "impose and control." That means, I will:
 - Ask permission to share.
 - Offer my insight simply, without going too far in trying to interpret it or apply it.
 - Release them to the Holy Spirit's confirmation. 1 Thessalonians 5:20-21
- c. **Directly**? If so, I will speak the truth in love boldly, trusting the Spirit to back up my obedience?

NOTES:

- 1. I will take care not to violate the priesthood of believers by "corrective, directive" words (OT).
- 2. I will measure my response by 1 Corinthians 14:3 NIV. "But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their <u>strengthening</u>, <u>encouragement</u> and <u>comfort</u>.
- 3. When I say, "Lord, if You speak <u>clearly</u>, I will obey <u>courageously</u>," I must not rush the first part.
